

2021-2022 Pell Lock-in Policy Effective Summer 2021

Pell awards will be recalculated twice in a semester, except for Summer 2021 and 2022.

For summer 2021, the only Pell award recalculation will be based on credits enrolled at 12:00 a.m. (midnight) on 6/22/2021, since summer semester is one 8 week term.

An end-of-term review will be done to insure students attended and incurred the cost for the credits for which they receive Pell or Pell will be decreased accordingly.

For fall 2021, the first Pell award recalculation will be based on credits enrolled at 12:00 a.m. (midnight) on 9/8/2021. The second recalculation will be based on enrollment at 12:00 a.m. 11/2/2021.

Students who increase their credits between 9/8 and 11/2 will receive an increase in Pell accordingly.

Students who decrease the credits between 9/8 and 11/2 must incur the cost for the credits, and attend, or Pell will be decreased accordingly. Be Advised: Dropping a late start class after Pell has disbursed will result in a balance due for repayment of the Pell previously awarded.

An end-of-term review will be done to insure students attended and incurred the cost for the credits for which they receive Pell or Pell will be decreased accordingly.

For spring 2022, the first Pell award recalculation will be based on credits enrolled at 12:00 a.m. (midnight) on 2/2/2022. The second recalculation will be based on enrollment at 12:00 a.m. 4/5/2022.

Students who increase their credits between 2/2 and 4/5 will receive an increase in Pell accordingly.

Students who decrease the credits between 2/2 and 4/5 must incur the cost for the credits, and attend, or Pell will be decreased accordingly. Be Advised: Dropping a late start class after Pell has disbursed will result in a balance due for repayment of the Pell previously awarded.

An end-of-term review will be done to insure students attended and incurred the cost for the credits for which they receive Pell or Pell will be decreased accordingly.

For summer 2022, the only Pell award recalculation will be based on credits enrolled at 12:00 a.m. (midnight) on 6/21/2022, since summer semester is one 8 week term.
